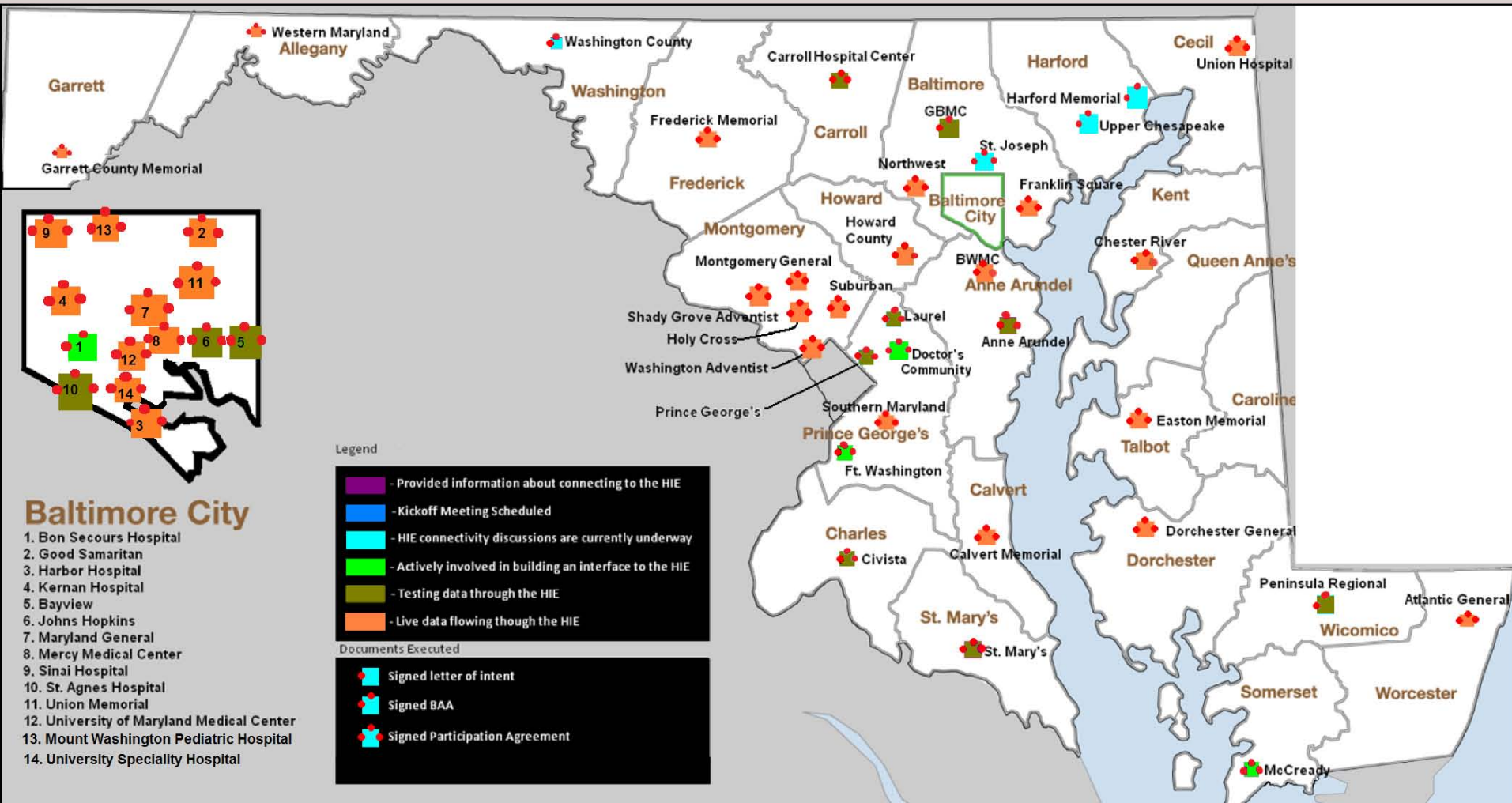

# Numbers at a Glance

Chesapeake Regional Information System for Our Patients

Progress Metric	Result
Live Hospitals	29 (48 expected by early Dec)
Live Labs and Rad Centers (non-hosp)	5
Live Clinical Data Feeds	30 (lab, rad, a clinical document feeds)
Live VPNs	59 (all hospitals)
Executed Participation Agreements	65 (43 hospital agreements)
Identities in MPI	~1.75M
Active Users (log-in w/in past 60 days)	173
Queries (past 30 days)	640
Lab Results Available	~ 2.7M
Radiology Report Available	~ 1.1M
Clinical Documents Available	~ 580K



# Current Core Focus Areas

Chesapeake Regional Information System for Our Patients

- ADT (encounter) Connectivity to support Hospital Admission Reporting
  - CRISP captures admission and discharge data
  
- Deployment of the CRISP Query Portal (also called “VHR”)
  - Encounters, Meds, Labs, Rad Reports, Clinical Documents
  
- Clinical Data Feed Connectivity
  - Ensuring we keep our momentum up with clinical data connections
  
- Ambulatory Connectivity Efforts
  - Results Delivery to Ambulatory Practices, CCD Connectivity
  
- Public Health Reports
  - Electronic Lab Results Delivery
  - Expect first site to go-live by end of year
